

Private Sponsor Group Commitment

The responsibilities undertaken by the Private Sponsor Group with respect to the Principal Applicant and all accompanying case members, including any members born after the Welcome Corps Application is submitted to CSH and before arrival to the United States, are described in Section C of the Welcome Plan and the Core Private Sponsorship Services (together the “Sponsorship Undertaking”) and include:

- Reception
- Lodging
- Care
- Assistance and Support
- 30- and 90-day progress reports
- Completion of the sponsor survey upon certification and again at 6 months and 12 months post-arrival.

We understand that we are jointly and individually responsible for:

- Performing the core sponsorship services as described in the Sponsorship Undertaking; and
- Assuming accountability for failure to carry out these responsibilities

We further understand that the responsibilities commence upon approval of our application.

We confirm that:

- The information provided in our application is to the best of our knowledge true, complete, and accurate.
- We have made or will make adequate arrangements in the sponsorship community identified in the Sponsorship Undertaking.
- We have sufficient financial resources and capacity to fulfill our sponsorship responsibilities.

We consent to CSH sharing information provided in our application with the United States government and partner organizations, including Private Sponsorship Organizations, for any of the following purposes: matching our Private Sponsor Group with a refugee case(s), providing our Private Sponsor Group with support and oversight to ensure the fulfillment of the Sponsorship Undertaking, and ensuring the safety and well-being of refugee(s) being sponsored by the Private Sponsor Group. This information may be shared by the United States government in accordance with the Department of State’s Systems of Records Notice 59 and Prefatory Statement of Routine Uses available at <https://www.state.gov/system-of-records-notices-privacy-office/>

We understand that false statements or concealment of any material fact may result in, but are not limited to, the following consequences: Refusal to approve this sponsorship application, refusal to approve future sponsorship applications, and revocation of this sponsorship application.

We understand that members of the Private Sponsor Group will be barred from signing or co-signing an additional application to sponsor another refugee or other refugees if the Private Sponsor Group is found to have defaulted on its responsibilities in a previous Sponsorship Undertaking, particularly where such default has seriously affected the wellbeing of the sponsored refugee(s), or where the Private Sponsorship Group has not rectified the circumstances for the default.

In the case of a dispute or disagreement with the refugee(s) we are sponsoring, we will make every effort in good faith to prevent a breakdown in the relationship and ensure the core sponsorship services are completed. Where we are unable to independently resolve disputes, we will work with CSH and/or our Private Sponsorship Organization to seek a resolution.

Once certified, we understand that we must be ready to receive the refugees we are sponsoring.

We have read and agree to abide by the Private Sponsor Group Code of Conduct.
